In 2009, Windcrest United Methodist Church a (501c3) began the Neighbors Helping Neighbors Ministry to address the needs of our “neighbors” in the community by providing:

- food assistance (groceries)
- hygiene items
- dog/cat food

We also provide **bus tickets** for those seeking employment opportunities as well as for doctor appointments when other transportation is unavailable.

Monthly funding for the San Antonio Food Bank to come to our campus is \$350. We are currently seeking assistance to continue this much needed food distribution. Each month with the 10,000 to 15,000 pounds of food received from the San Antonio Food Bank we serve approx.:

- 100-150 households
- 200 households in peak months such as summer

We have a faithful base of 25-30 volunteers that give numerous hours each month to this ministry.

We are in need of the monthly funding to be able to continue this service to the many in need in the northeast quadrant of San Antonio.

Windcrest United Methodist Church also has a Wesley Nurse provided through Methodist HealthCare Ministries to help the underserved through health education and referrals to promote wellness through self-empowerment and connecting spirit and body.
